BLOOMICE SL are committed to maintaining the highest level of professional and ethical standards in the conduct of its business globally, and is committed to sourcing minerals for its products in a socially and environmentally responsible way.

We are committed to full compliance with local governing laws and regulations and adhering to appropriate customer requirements applicable to the procurement of the refined metals used within our products. We continually monitor the ongoing adoption of industry practices related to the tracing and tracking of elements and minerals in order to understand the source of and improve transparency in the associated supply chain.

The definition of “Conflict Minerals” refers to gold, as well as tin, tantalum, and tungsten, the derivatives of cassiterite, columbite-tantalite, and wolframite, regardless of where they are sourced, processed or sold. We support these requirements as well as the humanitarian ambition of ending violent conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), and in surrounding territories, which have been in part, financed by the exploitation and trade of “Conflict Minerals”.

OUR COMMITMENT:

1. Support the aims and objectives of the U.S. legislation on the supply of “conflict minerals”.
- 2.. We maintain to not knowingly procure specified metals that originate from facilities in the "Conflict Region" that are not certified as “Conflict Free”.
3. Ensure compliance with subsequent requirements, and request suppliers undertake reasonable due diligence with their own respective supply chains to ensure that specified metals are being sourced only from:
 - Mines and smelters outside the “Conflict Region” or
 - Mines and smelters which have been certified by an independent third party as “Conflict Free” if sourced within the “Conflict Region”.

If discovered that the use of these minerals produced in facilities that are considered to be “non-conflict free”, in any material or component we procure, we will take immediate and necessary actions to source alternative product(s) from a “conflict free source”.
